

Disbarred or Suspended Attorneys Taking and Passing Examinations as a Condition of Reinstatement in 2020

The form of examination administered to disbarred or suspended attorneys varied among jurisdictions as follows: regular bar examination (10 jurisdictions), local component only (1 jurisdiction), Attorneys' Examination (1 jurisdiction).
